

Parents Code of Conduct

- Understand that Travel Baseball requires a higher level of commitment than Rec Ball.
- Players are expected to be committed to Top Rank Baseball for the duration of our season.
- Players are not prohibited to play for another Travel Team while on our Roster.
- If you are playing "Rec" ball, Top Rank Baseball must remain as your priority.
- Parents must refrain from unsportsmanlike gestures, talk, or profanity.
- Taunting players from the opposing team is prohibited.
- It is expected that parents show respect towards the umpires and their decisions, if needed coaches will discuss questionable calls with the umpires.
- Players will not throw bats, helmets, gloves or any object on or off the playing field at any time.
- Parents must accept the coaches' decision regarding playing positions and the amount of playing time.
- Siblings, parents, family or friends are prohibited from being in the dugout.
- Please support/remind your Son about working on his skills outside of practice, we will provide a 10-15 minute program to be done on off days.
- Ensure your player arrives on time for practice and games.
- Inform the coaches of any medical conditions of your player.
- Parents and spectators will be drug and alcohol free during practice or games.
- Parents will refrain from giving the players instructions during the game.
- Use positive encouragement to your player, his or her teammates, and coaches. All people perform at their best when they feel they are supported
- Defaming of coaches, players, or other parents VIA any electronic or social media will not be tolerated.
- Allow for a 24 hour "COOL DOWN" period before you discuss any serious concerns you
 have with a coach.
